## • The church and preschool ended October 2022 with a net combined positive gain of \$68,494

- The church ended October 2022 with a net loss of \$27,719.
- The preschool ended October 2022 with a net positive income of \$96,213
  (Income comparison for prior years does not include PPP forgiven income for church or preschool.)
- The church typically receives an average of 26% of their yearly budget donations in December.
- Pledges & Contributions for October YTD were down 6.5% compared to this time last year and 3.22% less than 2020. (2 Gifts equally \$80,000 received in Oct 2021 are believed to be delayed giving which will come later this year)
- Preschool revenues are up 12.5% this year over the same time last year and we continue to support a full enrollment.
- We remain within budget for church expense. Overall church expenses were up by 13.6% compared to the previous year.
- Preschool expenses are up 16% over this time last year, which is 3% less than the prior month.
