The church and preschool ended August 2022 with a net combined positive gain of \$27,734

- The church ended August 2022 with a net loss of \$26,159 (This is in line with where we pre-covid in 2019 and the usual summer, which has typically been covered by Q1 receipts.)
- The preschool ended August 2022 with a net positive income of \$53,893.
- Income comparison for prior years does not include PPP income in 2021
- Pledges & Contributions for August YTD were down 6% compared to this time last year and 6.6% less than 2020. (This is an improvement from 40% in January, 20% the end of the first quarter, and fits with the expected delayed giving.)
- Preschool revenues are up 10.5% this year over the same time last year and we continue to support a full enrollment going into the new school year.
- We remain within budget for church expenses. Overall church expenses were up by 18.5% compared to the previous year (Facilities up 24%, Admin up 33% due to returning to pre-covid activities and staffing up 22% due to staff return from furlough, hardship payments and new staff)
- Preschool expenses are up 18.4% over this time last year and includes increased activities, additional staff and wage increases
