- General Pledges and Contributions were up down less than 1% from 2023 and 1.3% lower than in 2022. (delayed giving has begun to come in during October.)
- Our **expenses year to date** were \$124,079 less than budgeted. Down 3.8% from last year and up 5.6% from 2022.
- We are currently carrying \$170,340 in building costs that could be paid with building reserve funds at end of year if needed. (included in above)
- The church ended the month with a **net negative position** of (\$70,204)
- If we moved the building costs year end, the **budget net would be a positive position of** \$100,136

- **Revenues** were less than budgeted by \$154,422. The revenue and expense differences are largely due to straight line budget and fewer children in Kindergarten than budgeted. Expenses were reduced to compensate.
- Tuition Revenue to date is 2.1% higher than in 2023 and 5.8% higher than 2022. New tuition rates in September are the largest contributing factor.
- Expenses were \$168,869 less than budgeted.
- The preschool ended the month with a **net positive position** of \$42,955.

The Church and Preschool combined ended the month with a net negative position of \$27,249.

Without the building projects, it would be a net positive of 143,091.

Additional Information:

At this time, there are no red flags for finances and we have seen some of the delayed giving begin to come in this October.
