- General Pledges and Contributions were up 1.1% from 2023 and 2.6% lower than in 2022. (There is \$95,000 of what we believe is delayed giving that had come in August previous years.)
- Our **expenses year to date** were \$121,319less than budgeted. Down 2.9% from last year. There was also a 3<sup>rd</sup> payroll in August this year that did not happen until September 2023.
- We are currently carrying \$92,790 in building costs that could be paid with building reserve funds at end of year if needed. (included in above)
- The church ended the month with a **net negative position** of (\$37,118)
- If we moved the building costs year end, the **budget net would be a positive position of** \$55,672

- **Revenues** were less than budgeted by \$195,221. The revenue and expense differences are largely due to straight line budget and fewer children in Kindergarten than budgeted. Expenses were reduced to compensate-
- **Tuition Revenue to date** is 1 % lower than in 2023 and relates to fewer kindergarten students, 3% higher than 2022.
- Expenses were \$138,176 less than budgeted. Also includes a 3<sup>rd</sup> payroll.
- The preschool ended the month with a **net negative position** of **(\$41,926)**. This is normal for the preschool summer. August is a high expense month as we restock school year supplies, and we had a 3<sup>rd</sup> payroll. We catch up when the new tuition rates start in September.

The Church and Preschool combined ended the month with a net negative position of \$79,044.

## **Additional Information:**

At this time, there are no red flags for finances. Summer is the lowest giving month for us typically. We also already anticipated a lower profit for the preschool this year based on how quickly we can raise tuition prices without crippling family versus how quickly we needed to raise teacher salaries. Tuition prices were raised starting this September and will begin to impact the preschool net position towards the end of the year.
